First, I agree with the provisions of this draft Boulder County Democratic Platform. Second, I found it impossible to rank the various issues in priority order of importance. In my opinion, it promotes competition, unnecessarily, among the many very important issues covered in the Platform. In that context, more than one plank deserves to be listed as number one in importance, concurrently. For example, I would place both “Issue B: Foreign Policy and National Security” and “Issue D: Civil Liberties” as number one in importance for the Federal Government. At the same time, I would rank “Issue A: Health Care” of top importance from both a state and national perspective.
